If your application is approved, you have to pay a small fee of **100 €** which includes accommodation, breakfast, dinner, and course material. After reception of the payment, your registration will be confirmed. Unsuccessful candidates may be given the opportunity to register paying the reduced or full fee (see below) provided there are free places left. Please note that there is **no guarantee whatsoever** on the availability of such places.

Please enclose following documents:

- a copy of your most recent degree (e.g., high-school diploma, “Vordiplom”, “Diplom”, B.Sc., M.Sc., ...)
- copy of certificates of completed courses or seminars, especially if related to the topics of the Summer School (programming courses, courses on numerical methods or on more specific topics like Statistical Physics, Mathematical Modelling, Biophysics, etc.)
- an application letter (approximately half a page), in which you explain your motivation for attending the School (e.g., planning to write or already working on a thesis in one of the subject areas of the School, general interest in Computational Science, etc.),
- at least one letter of recommendation.

Students from abroad may obtain a travel allowance. The amount of the allowance (for successful grant applications) depends on your point of departure and can be checked here (in German only). The numbers in the first column (*Spalte 1*) are relevant. Please indicate if you apply for such an allowance. Since the total funding for travel support is limited, students having the highest expenses (coming, e.g., from overseas) will preferentially receive a travel allowance.
